CASE REPORT DERMATOFIBROSARCOMA PROTRUBERANS : A RARE CASE STUDY Dr J T Basavaraj1, Dr Ravikiran H V2*, Dr Harshith Hegde3, Dr Abhinav Kumar Rai4 1Professor 2*, 4Post Graduate Student 4Associate Professor Department of General Surgery INTRODUCTION:

Dermatofibrosarcoma Protuberans (DFSP) is a rare soft tissue sarcoma that develops in the deep layers of skin. The incidence ranges from 0.5 to 1:1,00,000. It can present at birth or in childhood, most commonly between 20 to 30 years. De-regulated expression of PDGFB, autocrine stimulation of PDGFR is the molecular event. It may occur following trauma, arising from scars, burns or vaccination sites. Mohs micrographic surgery is effective or Complete local surgical resection with 1-3cm margins. If margins are positive, radiotherapy is adviced . IMATINIB tried in locally advanced and metastatic condition. Presents on trunk and proximal extremities, rarely on head and neck. Usually remains asymptomatic for years. 30 to 50 % recur locally after simple excision and even with 1-3cm margin excision. Metastasis are extremely rare, usually to lung with poor prognosis.

CASE REPORT :

- Here is a 60 year old female patient THIMMAKKA, came to Chigateri hospital Davangere, with complaints of swelling over the upper abdomen since 11 years, no other symptoms related to it.
- No past history, no co morbidity. Vitals were stable.
- <u>Local examination</u> : Non tender, horizontally oval swelling of size 9*5cm over the epigastric region, nodular surface with grooves in-between, firm to hard consistency, irregular and hyper pigmented borders, not mobile, skin was not pinchable over it, no pulsations.
- Wide local excision with 2cm margin with approximation of the skin done .Swelling was very vascular with deep local infiltrations intraoperatively. Sent for histopathology.
- Histopathology report came as Dermatofibrosarcoma Protruberans DFSP and Patient advised for further follow up as the recurrence rate is more.

DISCUSSION:

- Its incidence ranges from 0.5 to 1 : 1,00,000 : So this is one of the rare case.
 It can present at birth or childhood, most commonly 20 to 30 years : But here the patient age is 60 years old.
- It may occur following trauma, arising from scars, burns or vaccination sites: In this case there is no such past history.

Mohs micrographic surgery is effective, Here we did Wide Local Excision with 2 cm margin, with no recurrence even 6 months after the surgery (as in the figure).

CONCLUSION:

- Dermatofibrosarcoma protruberans (DFSP) over epigastric region is a very rare soft tissue sarcoma, which was symptomless for 11years, without any significant past history and was confirmed by Histopathology report after Wide Local Excision.
- No recurrence noted even 6 months after the surgery at operated site.
