As young students who enter the vast field of medicine, we are slowly and steadily etched into budding doctors by are dutiful professors and teachers. We are taught how to diagnose, treat and try to save all who come to us. The etio-pathogenesis of a

boggling number of

conditions are expected to be at our finger-tips and we proudly accomplish that with every exam that comes our way. But what about when we cannot get to the imminent patient in time? Then comes the real test, when we face our first patient, the true judge of our knowledge and mainly - compassion.

Cancer is one such disease which nobody can anticipate, or prepare for. Breast cancer is quickly evolving to be the most common cancer in women worldwide even surpassing cervical cancer. Statistics show that 1 in 8 women has a life time risk of developing breast cancer. Now as scientists, researchers and doctors we know the causative gene, the family risk, the incidence and how to treat- then why are we failing to save our women from passing on to the most aggressive stage of the disease before they come to us?

LACK OF AWARENESS - It is the single most detrimental factor along with more social factors like :-

- Stigma attached with cancer of the breast- most women are of the opinion- how is it possible, I lead a healthy life.
- Mortification-prevents women from self-examination and discussion which are both a far cry from consulting the doctor.
- False bubble of hope- "it cannot happen to me"- till it does.

This is where screening plays its massive role. The Department of Radio-diagnosis of JJMMC in its effort to raise awareness conducted a "FREE SCREENING MAMMOGRAPHY WEEK" from the 21st- 28th of FEBRUARY 2017, before which we had the herculean responsibility of informing the people of this drive. Flyer's were sent out, posters were made, the media was informed and invited to the inaugural ceremony on 21st February 2017 in Bapuji Hospital where our leaders made every effort to reach out to as many women as possible.

As an institution in a rural setting it is our moral responsibility to raise awareness on the issues that the people may not even think of. With the support of the department of preventive and social medicine we were able to reach more women and thus our drive began during which we saw around 120 women who came forward for screening.

Most of these women told me they had heard of mammography remotely and were going to get it done, but put it off thinking it was not immediately necessary since " nothing was wrong" - this is what we have to change, most others came to accompany their friends, but took the message home that their screening would have to be more dedicated.

One instance that confirmed my faith in what were doing - a fifty year old mother of three women aged 33y, 30y and 26y was recently diagnosed with Stage IV CA and was scheduled for a mastectomy. Now we couldn't help her, but her daughter were informed that there was a free camp in the hospital so why not get a screening done? Thats when we found suspicious lumps in two daughters.

At thirty they would have never fathomed the possibility of cancer or the need for a mammography and luckily for both women there were no definitie indicators of malignancy but they now have a clear warning to diligently follow up those nasty lumps! The existence of which they would not have known if not for our screening camp.

The week has left us humbled about the change we can bring about in the lives of so many people with just a little extra effort and i hope we continue to do so.


